Some birds met these changes well, adapting to new pressures and thriving and others no longer found it habitable. The surveys that have been completed are vital for park management. Comey's work shows us where we were in the aspects of plant and bird life. The new census by Beveroth demonstrates our current state and as we move forward enhancing the park to a more beneficial state, subsequent censuses will show us how we are doing and if we are headed in the right direction.
