Documentation. The majority of birds requiring documentation were properly documented again this year; those documentations have been forwarded to the Illinois Ornithological Records Committee for the permanent file. Unfortunately, the documentations for five significant Count day species were not received as required (despite several requests); so, those records (along with other poorly- and non-documented records throughout the state) had to be excluded from the report. One of the above five would have been a new count species and the collective total would have provided a possible new count record of 272 species. With the aforementioned exclusions, the number of species
printed in Table 8 will be lower than originally submitted by those county compilers.

Economic Considerations. As mentioned last year, birders spend a great deal of time and money in pursuit of birds. It's still impossible to get (or give) exact figures and no one has yet suggested alternate figures, so, the three arbitrary standards and designated values initiated last year will be used again this year: 1) an "average" value for a person's time - \$18/hour; 2) the price of gasoline (which continued to be about $\$ 3$ per gallon in early May) or the mileage reimbursement rate for using a vehicle ( 40 cents per mile); and 3) the cost of food and
drink (average of $\$ 16$ per person). And, as last year, there are several other figures that could and should be included in this compilation, i.e., motels or other overnight accommodations, variable pre- and post-count expenses, unrecorded mileage to and from the count site, equipment, apparel, etc. However, we'll keep it simple (if that is possible).

1) 1,426 participants times an average of $\$ 16$ for food/drink consumption $=\$ 22,816$
2) an average of 7.2 participation hours per person (1426) times $\$ 18$ per hour [ 7.2 is based 5153 daylight party hours x 2.0 persons per party +160 nocturnal party hours] $=\$ 187,690$
