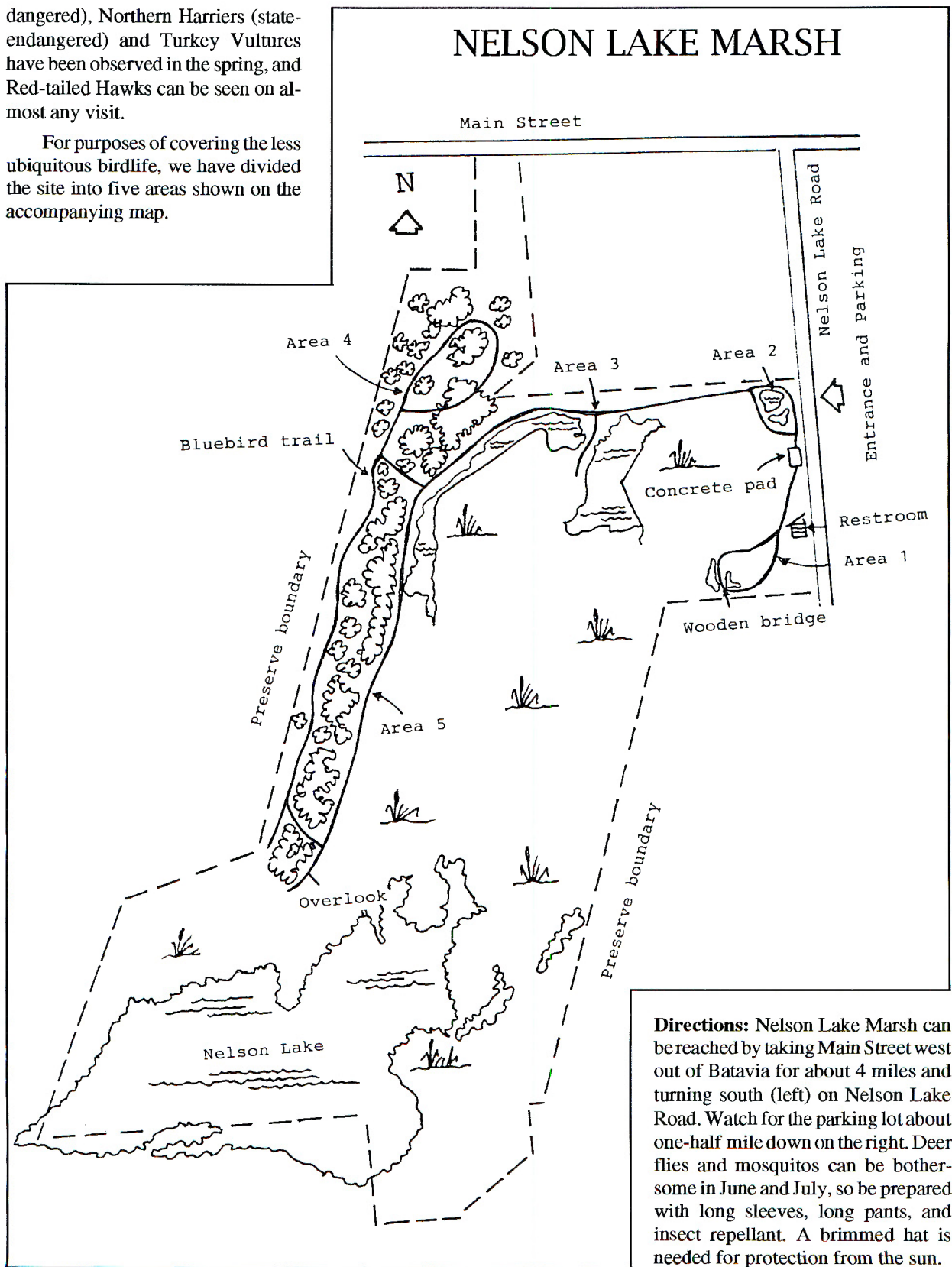


dangered), Northern Harriers (state-endangered) and Turkey Vultures have been observed in the spring, and Red-tailed Hawks can be seen on almost any visit.

For purposes of covering the less ubiquitous birdlife, we have divided the site into five areas shown on the accompanying map.



**Directions:** Nelson Lake Marsh can be reached by taking Main Street west out of Batavia for about 4 miles and turning south (left) on Nelson Lake Road. Watch for the parking lot about one-half mile down on the right. Deer flies and mosquitos can be bothersome in June and July, so be prepared with long sleeves, long pants, and insect repellent. A brimmed hat is needed for protection from the sun.
