First-year White Ibis

(*Eudocimus albus*), Carlyle Lake, Fayette County. 11 August 2003. Notice the white underbelly and white at bend of wing, two characteristics that help separate it from the Glossy and White-faced Ibises. The underbelly and bend of wings would be dark in the two Plegadis species. This White Ibis represents the 26th record for Illinois and the first since 1998 in the state.
