Mike Baum moved above the 140 per county level and Jim Mountjoy cracked the 100 species per county barrier by adding 1000+ ticks. Some other accomplishments of note were Craig Taylor breaking the 12K barrier and Keith McMullen adding over 1500 ticks this year. There are now 15 birders who have exceeded the 8,000 ticks mark, as Al Stokie and Urs Geiser join the group.
